



Gressenhall Farm and Workhouse Access Information Sheet

Getting about the museum, farm and grounds

Gressenhall Farm and Workhouse is a large site and visitors who find walking tiring might consider bringing a back-up chair, stick or walking frame if they have them. There are gravel paths around some of the workhouse buildings.

All buildings and displays have level access except for the School Room. There is a ramped entrance to the café and its courtyard garden.

There is a lift to the second floor of the workhouse building (see below for more details).

There are chairs in the museum buildings and benches throughout the grounds. Outdoors you will also find 'Resting Places' to lean on for a break.

There is a rough track to the farm. Please speak to Front of House staff on the day as they may be able to arrange for you to drive down to and park on the farm. On busy days it will not always be possible.

Wheelchair Hire

Gressenhall has 6 manual wheelchairs. Wheelchairs are available to visitors for FREE. Call 01362 869269 to book.

We also have an all terrain mobility scooter called a 'Tramper' available to borrow to aid access to the farm.

We recommend that you book in advance to avoid disappointment.

Carers

If you will be visiting with a carer, they enter the museum free of charge.

The museum courtyard and Café courtyard garden have wheelchair-friendly benches.

Toilets

There are accessible toilets in the café, workhouse building and on the farm.
