Toilets

There are toilets in the welcome area, café, ground floor of the museum, learning centre, school room and on the farm. Baby changing facilities can be found in the welcome area, café, workhouse and on the farm. There are disabled toilets available in the café, workhouse and on the farm.

No smoking across the site.

Only assistance dogs are allowed on site.

Woodland Playground Tips

On sunny days the slides may get hot.

On rainy days wooden surfaces can be slippery.

Watch out for static on some of the slides.

No smoking in the playground.

All children must be accompanied by a responsible adult.

Wash your hands thoroughly during and after your visit to the farm.

Please do not eat when visiting the farm.

Always wash your hands before eating.

Approach the farm animals quietly and gently.

Do not touch the animals - some may bite.

Be careful of deep water.

Take care crossing the road when visiting the farm.
