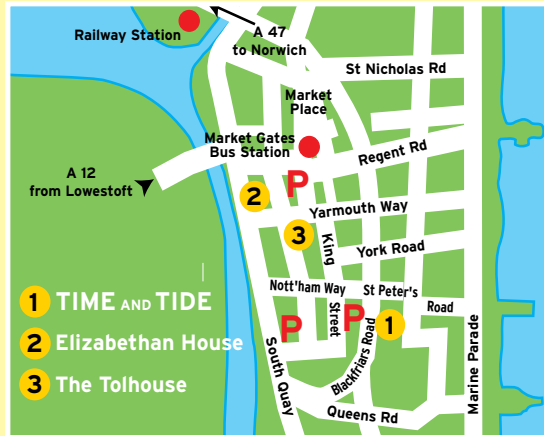

Children's University passport holders get free admission to Time & Tide, Tolhouse and Elizabethan House Museums and with each visit you can collect another stamp in your passport.



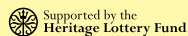
