



## EVENTS FOR SCHOOLS AT NORWICH CASTLE:

### KS1 and Lower KS2 A Dragon's Tale (Literacy)

#### Essential information

Maximum group size 60, £3.50 per student, 10am until 12pm

#### The event

Help a knight solve his dilemma in this literacy event! A cowardly medieval knight wants to marry the king's daughter, but must impress her father first. The king wants the knight to prove his bravery by slaying a fearsome beast that has been creating havoc in a neighbouring kingdom. The knight isn't at all keen on doing anything dangerous and decides that instead he will invent a story in which he defeats the beast.

Meet the knight and the court storyteller and visit the King's 'bestiary' to develop the story. Use drama and role play to build language, and work on vocabulary to create character description, story setting and sequencing. In helping the knight shape his story, reflect on the fact that the knight has lied in order to succeed. Is this fair? Will he get away with it?
