

## EVENTS FOR SCHOOLS, NORWICH CASTLE

### Missing Treasure

*Norwich Castle, Key Stage 2, max group size 60, £4 per pupil*

*A two-hour, led museum activity, 10am to midday.*

The scenario is a training event for would-be journalists. Pupils take on the role of trainee journalists attending a press conference to investigate the disappearance of an artefact from Norwich Castle Museum. The session takes place in our Anglo Saxon and Viking Gallery and in the Lecture Theatre.

Pupils are invited to interrogate the expert (a curator) and question a policeman at the crime scene. They make notes, attempt to discover what happened to the missing object, and prepare a draft newspaper report which can be developed back at school.



### Aims and learning outcomes

- Use the styles and conventions of journalism to report on an event.
- In non-narrative material, use simple organisational devices (for example, headings and sub-headings).
- Engage children with museum objects and environments as sources of inspiration and knowledge.
- Ask relevant questions to extend their understanding and knowledge.
