

EVENTS FOR SCHOOLS, NORWICH CASTLE

A Day with the Romans and the Iceni

Norwich Castle, Key Stage 2, max group size 120, £5 per pupil

A four-hour, led museum activity, 10am to 2pm.

The day is set some twenty years after Boudica's revolt, pupils get to meet Roman and Iceni characters as they look back on and reflect back on their two very different cultures.

Pupils will meet a Roman soldier and get to handle real Roman objects. They'll learn about how the Romans invaded and settled in Norfolk, bringing their own way of life. Two Iceni tribe members will talk about their own culture and life before the Romans.



Learning outcomes

- Handle replica and real Roman objects and understand how they were used and where they belong.
- Develop awareness of different ways of life in the past.
- Meet costumed characters who bring the castle to life.

- Understand the connections between local, national and international history.
- Learn about significant people in their own locality such as Boudica.
