KS4 Anglo-Saxon and Norman England

The event

Students will meet Saxon and Norman costumed characters to compare and contrast their cultures, re-enact the Battle of Hastings and Saxon rebellions, and take a tour of the Castle to discover why it was built, how it functioned and how important it was to the Normans.

Suitable for all exam boards. This event is different from the KS5 Anglo-Saxon England and the Norman Conquest event.

Aims and learning outcomes:

- Describe the society of late Anglo-Saxon England
- Explain how and why William of Normandy became King of England in 1066
- Describe and explain the Saxon rebellions
- Explain the key features, importance, nature and purpose of Norman castles in England
