
Reconstruction medieval prison cell at Norwich Castle, with a model of a prisoner sitting under some original medieval prisoners' graffiti.





This stone from the Castle was probably carved in the 13th or 14th centuries and is the earliest direct evidence of a named prisoner here. The text, in Norman French, simply says: 'Bartholomew, truly wrongfully and without reason, I am shut in this prison.'
