In conjunction with VISIBLE WOMEN, an inspirational exhibition at Norwich Castle celebrating a wide variety of modern and contemporary women artists, including Gwen John, Barbara Hepworth, Jo Spence and Anna Maria Pacheco.

Led-by artist MALCA SCHOTTEN you will experiment and focus on the basics of drawing and mark-making. Inspired by the Invisible Women exhibition, Malca will guide you to explore scale, line and tone using charcoal, pencil and pens through memory and observation.

Malca's aim is to encourage confidence and daring in drawing skills by encouraging a less self-conscious approach.

Malca's practice is driven by her love of drawing. She is author of a number of public arts projects, addressing issues appealing to a wide audience such as motherhood, coastal erosion and the ageing population. Malca has had numerous exhibitions both solo and as part of a group, in East Anglia - notably at Norwich Castle, Mandell's Gallery and Kettle's Yard - and in London with the National Crafts Council. Her latest project was Lives in Science at the John Innes Centre 2017.
