FREE A-LEVEL ART MASTERCLASSES AT NORWICH CASTLE 20TH AND 21ST SEPTEMBER 2018 / 10AM TO 2:30PM MAXIMUM 20 STUDENTS PER CLASS

In conjunction with The Paston Treasure: Riches and Rarities of the Known World exhibition (22 June to 23 September 2018), this is a chance for A-level students to develop their artistic thinking skills and techniques by working with a practising artist.

Artist Will Teather introduces his work as a painter, both looking at what it is like to work as an artist and by revealing some of his approaches to developing a sense of narrative and illusion within magical-realist artworks. A series of drawing activities will take place where students reinterpret items from the collections of the castle museum and create their own imagined worlds of curiosities. Many aspects of how to effectively create alternate realities will be discussed such as perspective, lighting and form, with reference to ideas around visual storytelling & magic-realism.

Will Teather's work has been exhibited internationally to acclaim, with recent exhibitions including as a guest artist for Artrooms London, Artwars at Red Dot Miami and as a finalist in the London Contemporary Art Prize. His work has been collected widely and in 2015 broke the sales record for the Other Art Fair, one of London's leading events for upcoming talent. His studio is based in Norwich, where he is an Associate Lecturer in drawing at Norwich University of the Arts.
