

## KS1 Christmas at Strangers' Hall

### Aims and learning outcomes

- *History:* Inspire pupils' curiosity about the past and equip them to ask perceptive questions, think critically and weigh evidence.
- Engage pupils with museum objects as sources of inspiration, knowledge and exploration.
- Recognise similarities and differences between objects from the past and their modern equivalents. Find out about changes in social history and Christmas traditions.
