Norwich Castle: Facts and Figures

- Norwich Castle Keep is one of the largest Norman keeps in England.
- Norwich Castle was the third Norman fortress to be built in England after the Tower of London and Colchester.
- 98 houses as well as streets and churches were demolished to make room for the castle.
- Norwich was the administrative capital of East Anglia during the Norman reign.
- In 1066 Norwich was the fourth highest populated town in England with a population in excess of 5000.
- More than 175,000 visitors visit the museum every year
- Norwich Castle has the largest collection of British ceramic teapots in the world (3,000)
