Cancellation policy

If you need to cancel your booking please give 21 days notice in writing. Failure to do so may result in a cancellation fee.

Access requirements

Ground floor displays and garden are fully accessible. There is no access to the first floor for wheelchair users or visitors with mobility difficulties. Please contact the Learning Officer to ensure all pupils will be able to participate in the activities where possible.

On the day

- Consult with your coach driver to determine to **drop off / pick up** points. Some coach drivers are happy to drop off outside the museum, others prefer to drop off at Thetford Bus Station with is a short walk from the museum.
- On arrival you will be met by a member of staff. The group leader will be asked to sign in and record the number of students and adults in the party. You will be

- directed to the cloakroom and lockers and, if you are staying for lunch, shown where this will be. You'll then be directed to the meeting place for your introduction.
- **The Museum Shop** has a range of pocket money priced souvenirs. We also offer a range of themed 'goody bags'. Prices start at £2. Goody bags need to be ordered in advance of your visit.

Responsibilities and expectations during your visit

The group leader has responsibility for adult helpers and for:

 briefing students and adult helpers <u>before the visit</u> on health and safety (see Risk Assessment Information), and on roles and responsibilities (see below).

All visiting teachers have responsibility for:

- their pupils' behaviour throughout the visit including led sessions and breaks
- sole responsibility for the welfare of their pupils during breaks and lunchtimes.

Adult helpers are expected to:

- assist the teachers who are responsible for pupils' behaviour
- stay with their group at all times, especially during breaks and lunchtimes.
- be responsible, in case of evacuation, for escorting their group to fire assembly point, taking the register and reporting any missing person to museum staff.

Students are expected to have a responsible attitude and show regard for the fabric of the museum, its contents and other museum visitors.

Departing the museum

When you are ready to leave, we recommend you phone your driver to check the coach is waiting for you. If there's a delay you'll then be able to wait in the museum rather than on the roadside.
